HOW TO DRAW PEOPLE

Level 2: ages 6+

LAYOUT



Turn your paper so that the longest sides are on the left and right (AKA, hamburger style!!!)



We are going to learn how to draw portraits of people today! Don't forget to plan a weekly art time to create your other three drawings before your next box comes!



1. Draw a big oval with a skin tone in the center of your paper.

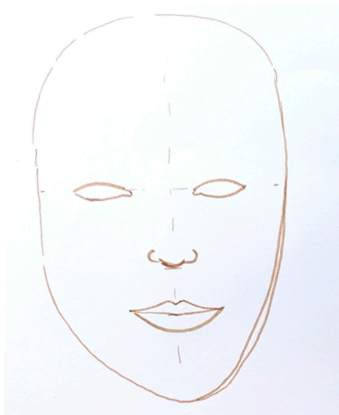


If you want a challenge, try to make the chin look like the chin of the person who you are drawing!

DETAILS

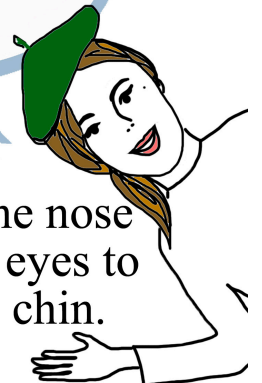
2. Draw super light skin-tone dashed lines that split the face in half. Make one across horizontally (side to side). The other line should be in the middle of the face vertically (up and down).

3. Draw the eyes, nose, mouth, and brows.



Don't forget to make people look unique!

Eyes will go on the horizontal line, halfway between the top of the head and the chin. The nose should go a third of the way down from the eyes to the chin. And mouth roughly halfway to the chin.





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HOW TO DRAW PEOPLE

Level 1: ages 3+

LAYOUT



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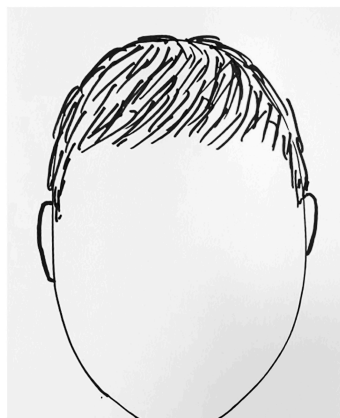


1. Use the foam oval as a guide! Trace around it with your black marker. Look, you just made a person's head!!!

DETAILS

2. Next, draw the hair. You will use long lines for the hair if the hair is supposed to be long. Use short lines if the hair is short!

How the hair might look:



The hair is ON the head, not on top of the head!



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HOW TO DRAW PEOPLE

Level 2: ages 6+



If you want to try something tricky, add an open smile! First, draw the outline of the smile. Then, draw the lips. After that, draw the tops and bottoms of the teeth!

FEATURES CONTINUED

4. Draw the ears! If the person's ears show, you will draw them starting at (about) eye-level, down to where the bottom of the nose sits on the face.

For a challenge, try adding lines and shadows to the face and ears where you see them!



5. Trace the portrait with a permanent marker if you haven't already.



6. Color in the portrait with your skin-tone markers and with whatever glitter color you got in your box!

Add confetti!



Don't forget to tell your friends how much you love your box!

HOW TO DRAW PEOPLE

Level 1: ages 3+ FEATURES



3. Draw the eyes halfway down from the top of the head. Try folding the foam in half to see where the halfway mark is!

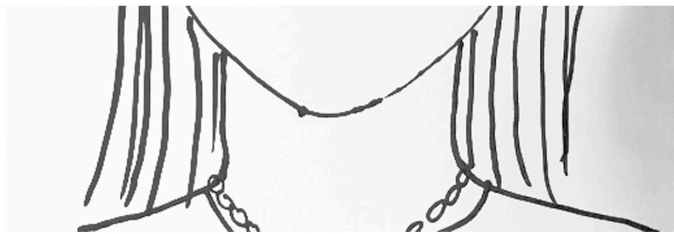


4. Draw the nose. Make it about three or four fingers-width below the eyes.

5. Put the mouth a little below the nose, as you see here.



Add lips if you want to get fancy!



6. Draw the neck and shoulders.

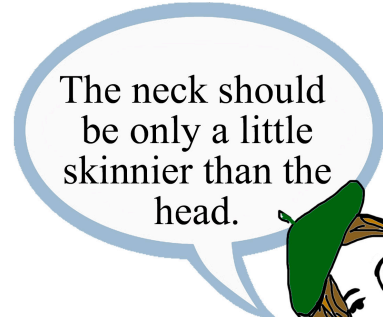
COLOR BACKGROUND



& ADD CONFETTI



7. Color in your **PORTRAIT**. Then, add dots of glue behind your person and put confetti on them!



The neck should be only a little skinnier than the head.
