



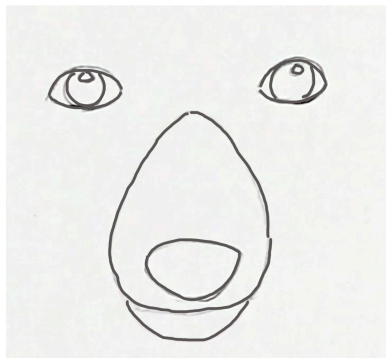
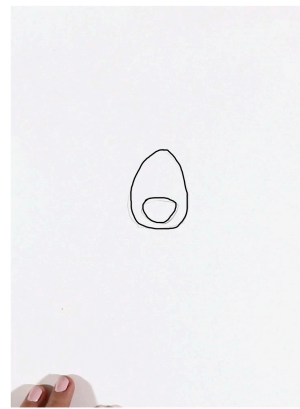
# KOALA WOW

## A MIXED MEDIA PROJECT



Set up your paper so that the longest edge goes up and down (vertical) in front of you. Put a small amount of water in your water cup and set out one purple paper, one white, scissors, glue, and paint.

1. Start in the center of the page and use your pencil to draw the nose shape. Then draw an egg shape around it to look like a snout.



2. Draw the eyes right above the top of the snout by making two football shapes with curved lines inside. Also, add in two small circles that you will leave plain.

3. Draw the shape of the bear's body and ears. Use little lines that go away from the bear to make it look like fur!

4. Go back over your lines with your permanent marker so it stands out.

5. Paint the bear with whatever color you desire. I used black for the body and brown for the snout and ears. You can add shadows and highlights if you use both of the colors together.

6. Add stippling to the nose. Stippling is a drawing technique that shades an area with small dots.



7. Draw leaves, flowers, or something else in the space around the bear. You will glue these onto the background later.

8. Paint the leaves (or whatever else you drew) surrounding your bear.

9. Cut out the bear. Then use the scissors to make snips along the edges so they look furry.

10. Give the bear any last-minute accessories if desired. Try adding glasses or a bowtie.

11. Use your glue stick to apply glue all over the back of the bear and then press the bear onto the paper until secured.



12. Cut out the leaves. Please be careful and make sure your fingers are nowhere near the metal. Keep out of reach of small children.

13. Glue the leaves down on the background. Make sure you glue them in a nicely balanced way.



14. Now it's time to clean up! Set your art aside, put the lid back on the glue, throw away scraps of paper. Put your new art supplies where they go.
