

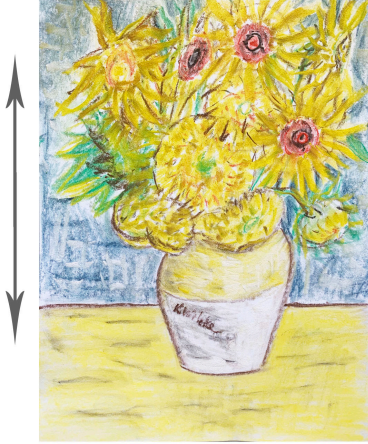


PASTEL SUNFLOWERS

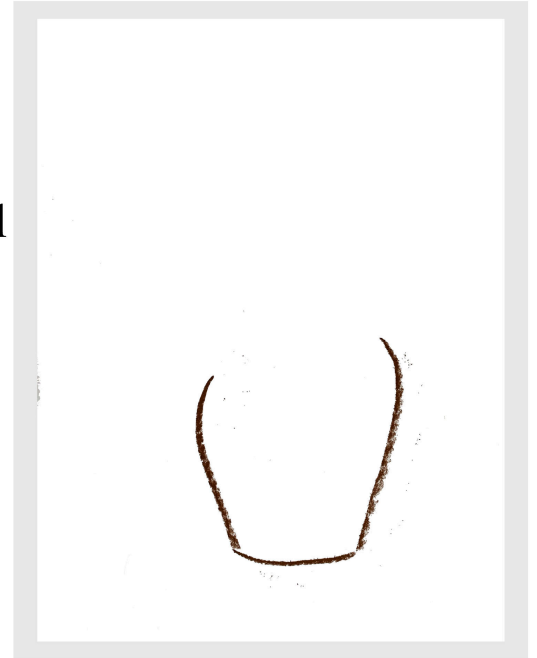
VAN GOGH STYLE VASE!

All Students:

Set up your paper so the longest side is vertical.
Like this!



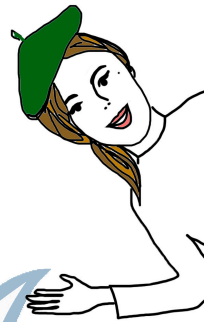
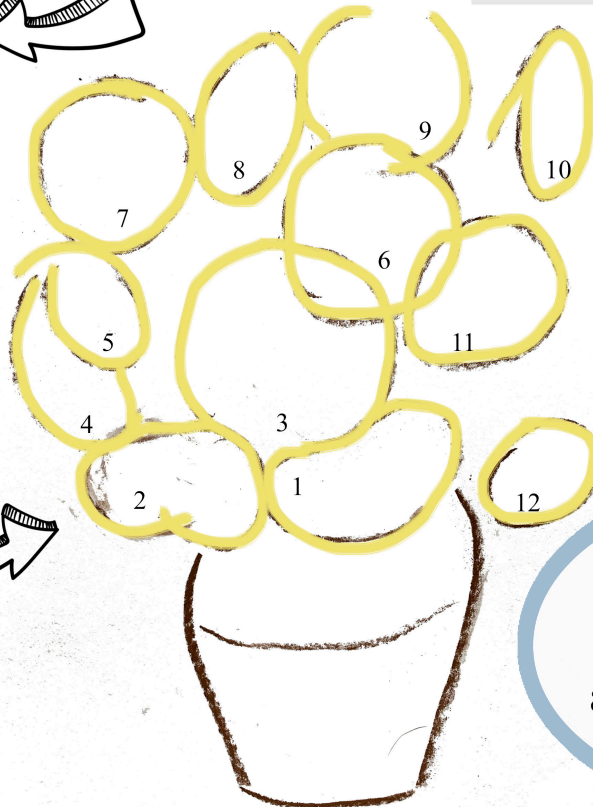
1. Take the brown pastel and draw the sides and bottom of the vase, like this:



2. Add a curved line in the middle of the vase.



3. Use the yellow pastel to draw 12 sunflowers above the vase. It should look something like this when you are done.



Don't add numbers to your drawing, they are there to guide you!

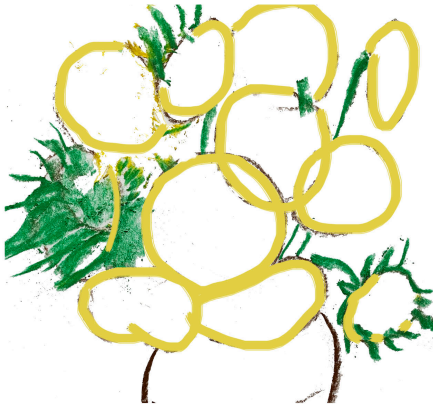
Note: our younger friends will have a more difficult time placing the flowers and that's ok!

4. Use the green pastel to color the leafy green parts of the flowers and make stems.

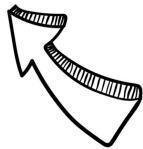


5. Add red circles in the middle of three of three flowers on the top right. Blend with the blending stump in an outward motion from the center of the flowers.



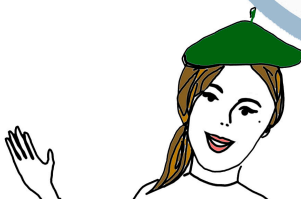
6. use the yellow pastel to make lots of petals on the flowers like sun rays!

7. Color the bottom half of the vase white.



8. Color the top half of the vase yellow. Now use the blending stump to blend the vase too!

9. Now draw a brown, horizontal line across the background, half way up the vase. This makes it look like a table!

10. Color in the table with the yellow pastel. Then blend.



11. Now color the background blue. First color with an up & down motion and then side to side.



12. Lighten the blue by coloring over it with white.



13. Add black or brown to a few of the flowers.

14. Add brown shadows on the bottom left side of some of the flowers. Then add a few shadows to some of the petals. Also, add a few red accents to some of the other flowers.



15. Now blend the flowers using strokes in the direction of the petals!



16. Add shading to the left and right edges of the vase. Then, blend it in.

17. Draw small black lines horizontally on the vase and table cloth. Then blend the vase and table!



18. Write your name on the vase, just like Vincent Van Gogh did!
