



# Elementary ARTIST BOX



Practice drawing a pine tree here! →



1. Begin by coloring over the paper with dark blue pastel. (0:04)

2. Layer purple, pink, and a bit of yellow pastel over top of the blue pastel. (0:22)

3. Use the white pastel on the bottom 1/4th of the paper to make it look snowy. (0:51)

4. Make a tree trunk with your dark green pastel and layer brown over top. Seeds: use the brown pastel only. (1:17)



5. Add dark green evergreen branches. You can zigzag out from each side of the tree trunk if you want or you can make detailed branches. Then blend. (1:34)



6. Use a black pastel to shade the trunk, under the branches, and under the tree. (2:27)



7. Make yellow lights on the tree. (3:04)

8. Add white highlights to the snowdrifts and yellow reflections on top. (3:33)

9. Add gold ornaments to your tree and accent them with red. Then, add red reflections to the snow. (4:02)

10. Add black shadows and yellow highlights to the branches for more contrast and detail. (4:27)

11. Create more colorful ornaments and reflections. (4:53)

12. Make a yellow star (or something else you want to draw) on top of the tree. (5:09)



Then, add a white highlight in the star to make it look like it's glowing.



13. Layer white snow on top of the branches. (5:31)

14. Speckle snow all over the sky. (5:46)
