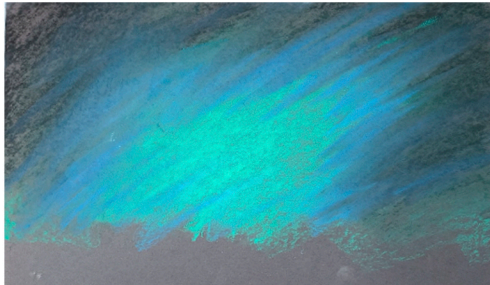




# Elementary ARTIST BOX

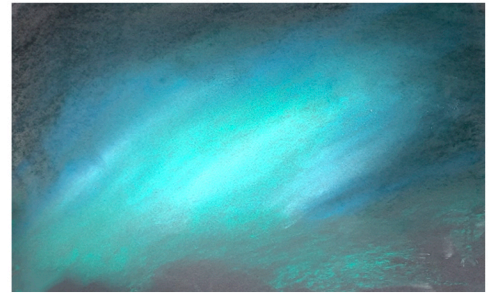


Practice blending colors here! →



1. Use a teal color to color the top half of the black paper. (0:06)

2. Add a layer of black around the top corners of the paper. (0:22)



3. Add dark blue between the teal and black pastel. (0:40)

4. Add light blue and white accents over the teal center. (1:01)

5. Add a black horizon line. (1:25)



6. Draw a tree on the horizon line with the black pastel. (2:03)



7. Use the black pastel to add hills over the horizon line. (2:35)



8. Add twinkling stars in the sky with white and yellow pastel dots! (2:46)

9. Add more trees to the horizon line. (3:16)



10. Add a big tree in the foreground. (4:22)



11. Use yellow + white to add highlights to the trees and snow! (4:50)

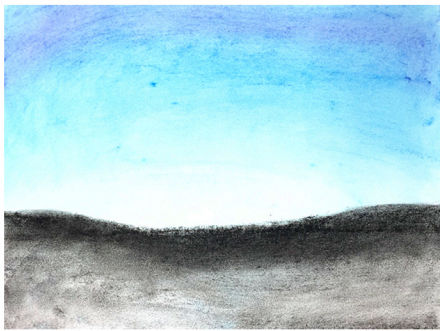




# Elementary ARTIST BOX



Practice blending colors together! →



1. Start by coloring the sky blue and adding accent colors. (00:55)

2. Create a black horizon line & lightly shade below it. No need to make the ground black, just some shadows. (2:03)



3. Draw small vertical lines sticking out of the horizon line. Then, add branches to the trees to make pines! (3:01)



4. Add dark green highlights to the trees. Then, carefully blend. (3:54)



5. Darken shadows under the trees. Then, add a layer of white snow to the ground. (4:54)

6. Give some variation to shadows under the tree trunks by adding brown. Blend. (5:27)



7. Add some more snow (if needed) and white bunny tracks and a brown bunny in the snow! (5:56)



8. Add more trees in the background in the middle. *(optional)* (6:34)

9. Add more color in the sky. Try pink clouds and a yellow sunset! (7:22)
