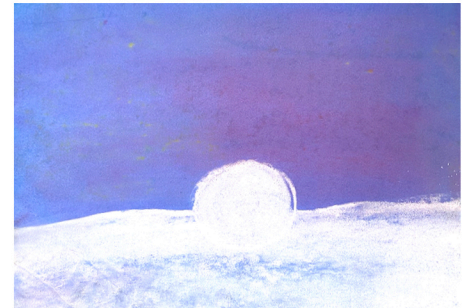


Practice drawing a round circle and shading it here! →



1. Start with a blue, purple, and pink sky and a white snowy ground. (0:04)

2. Make a white circle with half of it on the snowy ground and half sticking above the horizon line into the sky. It should be about as big as your fist. (0:24)



3. Use black and blue pastels to add a shadow around the bottom right edge of the circle. Then, blend it into the circle with a circular motion. (0:47)



4. Add a shadow under the circle you just made. (1:11)

5. Draw two more smaller, white circles on top of the first one. (1:22)

6. Use black and blue pastels to shade the bottom right edges of the top two circles you just made. Again, blend in a circular motion. (1:34)

7. Add black "coal" buttons and an orange carrot nose. (2:15)

8. Draw a hat, any hat! If you want to follow the example, we will draw a horizontal line across the forehead of your snowman and add a smaller square on top. (2:49)

9. Add brown stick arms to your snowman. (3:21)



10. Add shading to the arms by adding black accents under the arms. (3:38)

11. Create a colorful scarf by making a thick line under the snowman's chin, then draw lines for the ends of the scarf. Add a colorful pattern if you want! (4:11)



12. Shade slightly under the hat, scarf, and nose. (4:57)



13. Make footprints around the snowman so it looks like someone just built your cute snowman! (5:33)
