Today we're going to create a heart with our new dot painters!

### Draw the Basic Shape

1. Draw the basic shape of a heart with the red paint dotter.
2. Dot red paint in the bottom third of the heart.



Pro tip: later this week, review the concept of a third with your child and see if they remember. If not, review again & also talk about halves and wholes to help them understand.



3. Next, add an orange stripe above the red stripe. This will take up about another third of the heart.

4. After the orange row, finish the top of the heart with the yellow paint dotter.

5. Finally, dot around the outside of the heart with the blue paint dotter.

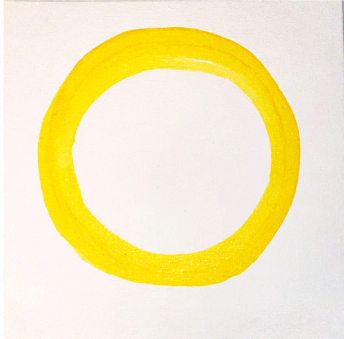


Now you're done with your first project!



Week 2

Preschool ARTIST BOX



Today we're going to create a smiley face! Get your supplies ready to start dotting!

**Draw the Basic Shape**

1. Draw a circle with the yellow paint dotter. If it isn't quite round, just make adjustments as needed. Just do your best and work hard. If you can't get it exactly round that's OK.

2. Use the blue paint dotter to make two eyes.



3. Then, still using the blue paint dotter, make the smile.

**Fill in the Colors**

4. Dot yellow all over the smiley face (except for on the eyes and smile).



5. Finally, dot the purple paint dotter all around the smiley face on the canvas.



Yay! Clean up & celebrate your hard work!



Week 3

Preschool ARTIST BOX



Today we're going to create a beautiful rainbow! Do you remember the order of the rainbow? Let's see!

Make the Rainbow

1. Use the red dotter to dot out the inner arch of the rainbow.

2. Dot the orange paint right above the red.



3. Dot yellow paint above the orange arch.

4. Dot green paint above the yellow arch.



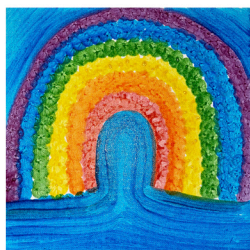
5. Dot blue paint above the green arch.



6. Dot the purple paint as the final arch of the rainbow.



What's the order of the rainbow?  
ROY G. BIV!  
Red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo (bluish purple where blue and purple overlap), and violet (purple).



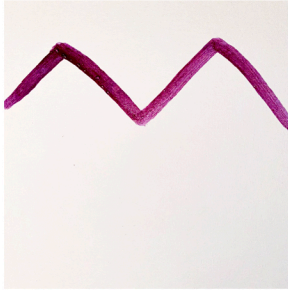
7. Finally, make blue lines around the rainbow!

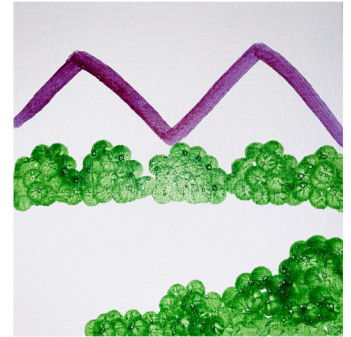


Today we're going to create a mountain scene! Get ready to draw some awesome lines and make some fun dots.

**Draw the Basic Lines**

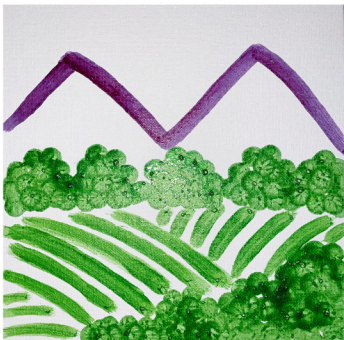
1. Begin by drawing a zigzag line with the purple paint dotted toward the top of the canvas.

2. Next, dot green bushes under the mountains.



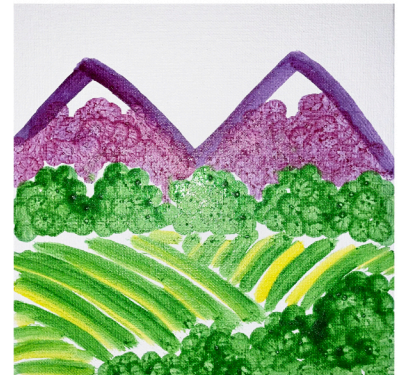
3. Then, dot some green bushes toward the bottom right of the canvas.

4. Add green lines going in a few different directions so that it looks like a field.



5. Fill in the mountains with purple dots, but leave the tippy top of the mountain plain white.

6. Add yellow paint between the field.



7. Dot the sky blue.
