

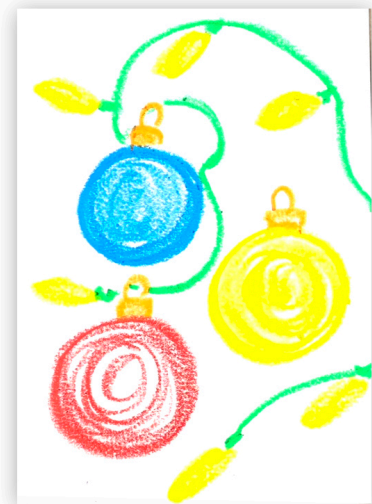
1. Start by drawing three big circles on your paper. Do you want to use blue, yellow, and red? What colors would you like to use?

2. Add orange rectangles with a small semi-circle on top of the colorful circle ornaments so that they look like hooks.



3. Make yellow almond shaped Christmas lights in the background, around the ornaments.

4. Draw a green cord connecting the Christmas lights. To draw the cord, make a curving or curly line that snakes around the ornaments.





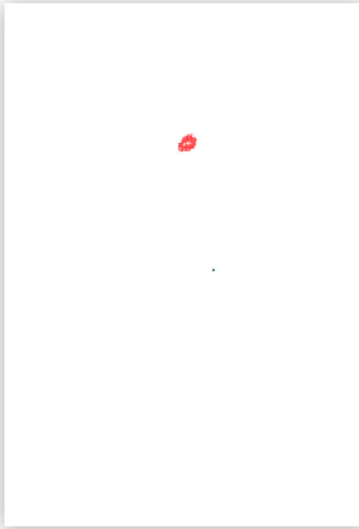
5. Fill the ornaments in with color if you haven't already. Then, paint water over top of them so they look like a watercolor painting instead of a crayon drawing!

6. Now that your drawing is a painting you can decide if you want to add more details to it. Try making designs on top of the ornaments. How about adding little lines to the cord of the Christmas lights so it looks more realistic?



When you're all done... celebrate!!! You just made an awesome drawing and turned it into a painting!





1. Make a red dot in the center of your paper toward the top. This will help you see where to start the top of the tree.

2. Draw a green zig zag line that starts right above the red dot and goes downward toward the outside edge of the paper. Repeat this zig zag line on the other side of the tree. Then,

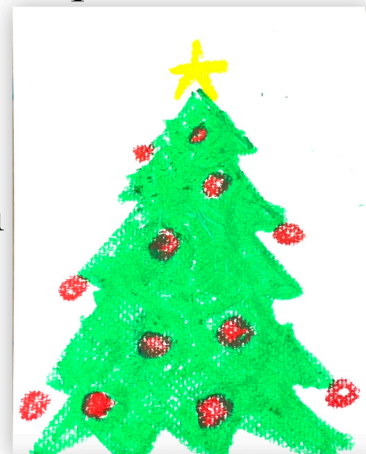


add the same line under the tree so it looks like a big zig zag triangle.



3. Draw more red dots on the tree so they look like ornaments. Then, add a yellow star on top. Is there anything else you want to add?

4. Color in the shape of the tree with the green crayon. Don't color over the red ornaments. If you do, they will turn brown when we add water.

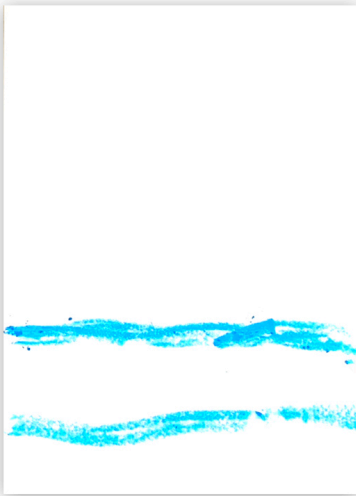




5. Paint the tree all over with water, being careful to avoid the ornaments and star. Clean your brush and carefully paint over the ornaments. Clean your brush again and paint over the star.

6. If you want to make your painting even more special, your last step will be to make yellow dots all around and on top of the tree. These can look like Christmas lights! No need to paint water over them, let them stay bright!





1. Draw two blue jagged, horizontal lines toward the bottom of your paper. These lines will be snow!

coming out of it. This will be the light!

2. Next, draw a yellow oval in the middle of your paper with lines coming out of it. This will be the light!



Connect the lines coming out of the light with another curved line to make it look extra glowy!

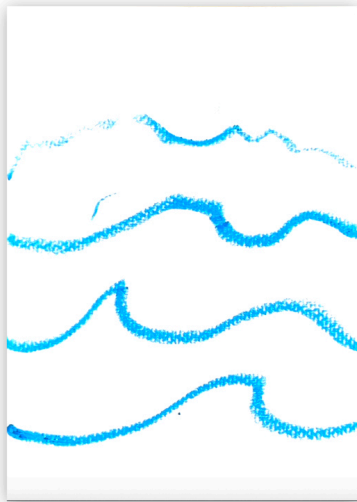


3. Draw a purple hat on top of the light and a vertical, purple line down below.

4. Color the background sky blue.

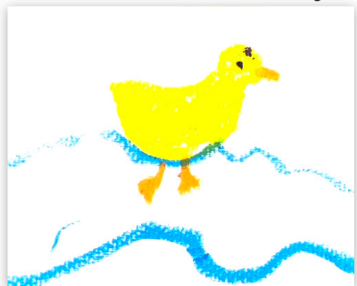
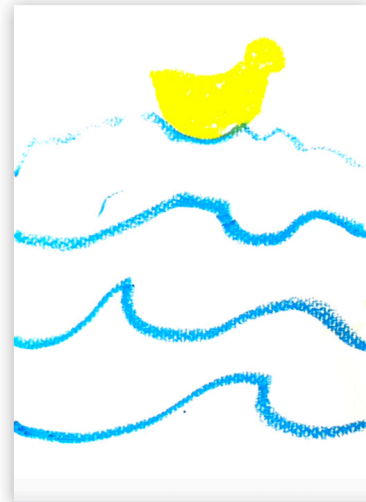


5. Paint the sky with water so it looks like a painting. Paint over the snow too. Then, clean your brush and paint the light and the lamp post.



1. Draw four wavy lines across your paper. Leave some empty space on the very top of the paper where you will draw a ducky!

2. Use your yellow crayon to draw the shape of the duck's body sitting on top of the water (it will look like the shape of a smile). Then, add a round head on the right end of the body.



3. Draw orange duck feet, bill, and wing, along with purple eyes.

4. Draw diagonal lines in-between the water waves to help make the water more blue once we paint over it with real water.

5. Paint over the water with water. Then, clean your brush and paint over the duck. Be careful to not blend the purple eyes into the yellow duck or else that part will turn brown.
