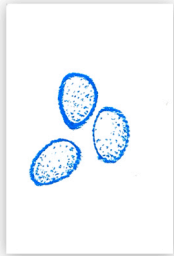


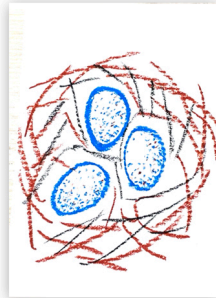


Watercolor Resist Nest

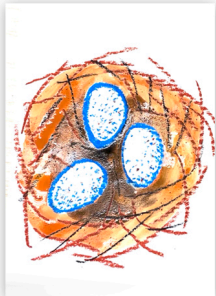


1. Choose a color of Cray-Pas and use it to make three ovals in the center of your paper. Add speckles or other details to help texturize them.

2. Now that you have your eggs figured out, use a brown, black, or yellow Cray-Pas crayon to arrange some stick-like lines so that it looks like a nest is circled around the eggs.



3. Once the nest and eggs are drawn, use your watercolor paint to fill in around the eggs so that the nest looks finished. For a challenge, add shading.



4. Paint the eggs with a bright blue or other color you think would look awesome!



5. Use paint to add a shadow on the eggs.

Finally, add some leaves and other details outside the nest. Then, fill them in with paint and possibly paint the background too!

Watercolor Resist Plant



1. Set up your workstation and take out your Cray-Pas. Draw a bumpy horizontal line to show where the ground is. Then, add green, brown, & black roots. Add brown rocks if you would like.

2. Next, draw the stem and leaves of the plant using one of your shades of green Cray-Pas.



3. Fill in the dirt with black Cray-Pas crayon. Then add black or brown watercolor paint to the underground dirt so that the ground looks finished.



4. Paint yellow or brown paint over the rocks if you added them.



5. Paint the plant green or another color of your choice.



6. Finally, use yellow paint or crayons to add sunshine to the sky. Then, add blue accents if you desire.
