



Watercolor Canvas Collage




1. Fill the little watercolor cups with a small amount of water and let it mix a bit. Then, with your table cover down, paint or pour the paint on the canvas and the small pieces of paper that came in your box. The colors will be light and watery. Let them dry before moving onto Step 2.

2. While your papers and canvas dry, begin cutting out both organic and geometric shapes of gold brown paper.




Take a break if the canvas needs more drying time.



3. Then, when you can set the paper on the canvas without the paper getting wet, begin figuring out how you may want to arrange the collage papers on your canvas in a balanced way.

4. Once you like your composition, start gluing down your design piece by piece.



5. Once you get your collage arranged and looking good, use small pieces of yarn and gems to add to your design in a balanced way.



Mixed Media Collage



1. Set up your workstation and take out the largest white sheet of paper to use as the background of your next collage.




2. Use your pencil to draw a shape like a plant or the shape of something you might find in your yard.



3. Rip some brown craft paper to use as the ground of your “representational” collage.



4. Make some shapes by cutting them out with your scissors or rip them with your hands to add surprises to your design.



5. Glue all of the pieces down so the collage looks like one big picture.



6. Finally, use the other collage supplies like the gems and yarn to add to your design. If you would like to add more color, paint between the collage pieces!
