



Diy Dragon Drawing



1. Begin by drawing the dragon's back, neck, head, belly, and tail. It doesn't matter which order you draw them in, but it may be easiest to begin with the head or back.
2. Add wings, teeth, eyes, arms, and legs. How does your dragon look? Do you want to add more?

3. Create the arch of a cave behind it, angry eyebrows above the eyes, and fire breath.

4. Then, darken the lines now (if you want), make spikes on the dragon's back, and add any additional details and patterns to the dragon.




5. At this point you can also add some rocks on the wall behind the dragon and on the ground.


6. Now it's time to color it!

Which colors do you want to use when coloring your new coloring page?! Color it now.



✓ Color the inside of the cave black (or another color of your choice).

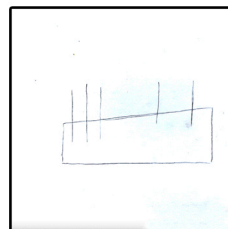
✓ Color the dragon and!  shade the color darker where you want to add shadows. Keep adding other colors where you want them!

✓ Color the side of the cave with the brown pencil. Then,  add shading to all the areas of your drawing that make sense.

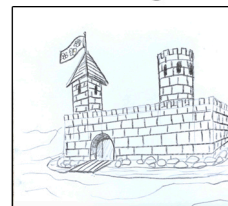
Cool Castle Coloring Page



1. Begin your drawing with three vertical lines slightly left of the center. Then, make two vertical lines toward the right side of your paper.
2. Once you have those vertical lines, make a 3-D rectangle under it that slightly overlaps the bottom edges of the vertical lines.

3. Next, add a pyramid on top of the left three vertical lines. Make a flag on top.


4. Draw an upward curve connecting the two vertical lines (on the right). Then, add bricks on top of the curve.



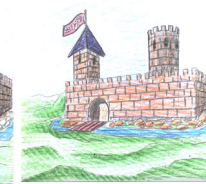
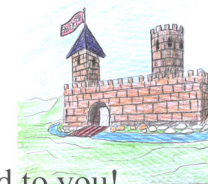
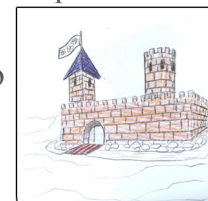
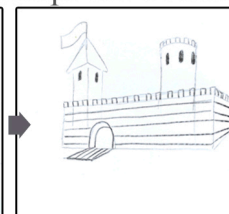
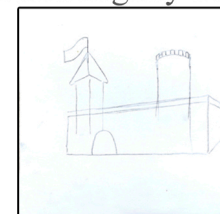
5. Make the same brick pattern on top of the 3-D rectangle shape you made in Step Two so it looks like a castle.

6. Add some windows on the two top structures. Then, add vertical lines on the whole castle.

7. Draw a drawbridge, rocks, and moat. Decorate them too.

 8. Now make the alternating brick pattern to help make the castle look even more realistic.

 9. Color it all in as it looks good to you!
