





a multicolored fish

Week 4




1. Let's make a colorful fish! First, outline the shape that you want. You can start with the gold color paint stick OR try outlining with the green paint marker if you want. This way you can have a more precise shape.

2. Next, fill in the top section of the fish shape with the gold.



3. Add red paint below the gold and begin to let the two colors blend together.




4. Paint in the bottom section and tail with your blue stick.




5. Blend a little more red over the gold section (as needed).

6. Make green fins coming off of the fish's body. Make a long fin on top, and two smaller under the fish's belly.



7. Make blue & yellow (gold) stripes on the fins & tail.



8. Complete the painting with a purple background.



9. Finally, add details like green stripes on the fins and tail, a white eye with a green dot, and white scales on the body.



i heart art

Week 1



1. Use the red Chunky Paint stick to make the shape of a heart. Then, fill it in.

2. Next, use the gold stick to outline the heart.



3. Use the blue stick to outline between the red & gold. What new colors are you making when you put blue on the heart? What color is mixing as you put the blue on top of the gold?



4. Try outlining the heart again with purple and see if it changes the shade of purple on top of the red. Then, make purple dots inside the heart.



5. Use green to fill in the background of the canvas. Make sure to get around the edges of the canvas!



6. Make your heart shine with radiating silver lines.

7. Let the project dry (it is paint).



8. Use your white and green paint markers to make a whole new design or complement your heart design on top of your "stick painting." What will you do for yours? Follow along or make up your own design!
