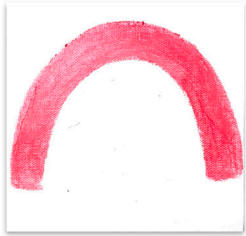




## rainbow promise

Week 3



1. Let's make a rainbow! Use the red paint stick to make an arch across the square canvas!

2. Directly under the red arch, make a golden (yellow) arch that overlaps the red. Overlap them so they mix and make orange!



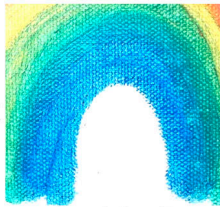
3. Under the yellow color, make a green arch. The green can overlap the yellow a bit, but it doesn't need to much.



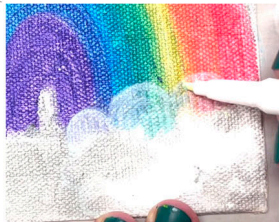
4. Next, make a blue arch under the green.

5. Finally, make a purple arch under the blue.

Of course, each arch should fit inside the others.



6. Once your rainbow is finished, fill in the background with silver paint. At the same time, outline around the



clouds. Leave the inside of each cloud white.

7. Finally, use your white marker to outline

the clouds. Fill them in a little more with silver paint. Then, go back over with more white.

8. Outline the rainbow with the green paint pen.



## a lovely landscape

Week 2



1. Use the blue paint stick to create a sky on the top half of your next canvas!

2. Paint clouds in the sky with your silver paint stick.



3. Fill the grassy earth with the green color.



As you make the grass, it may look good to go back over it with dabs of green paint so it has a grass-like texture.

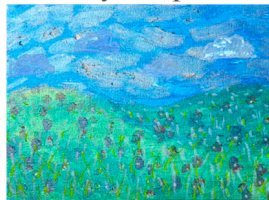
4. Add yellow highlights and blue shadows. Try making the tops of the hills gold and the bottoms of the hills a little more blue.



5. Once your landscape is looking artsy and just how you want it (YOU are the artist!), decide if you want to add flowers into the field. If so, try adding small red and purple marks on the grass.



6. Let your painting dry. These paint sticks are so



cool because they are less messy than paint & a brush, but it is still wet paint as it goes onto your canvas.

7. Finally, use the white and green paint pens to create more fine lines like grass or clouds.
