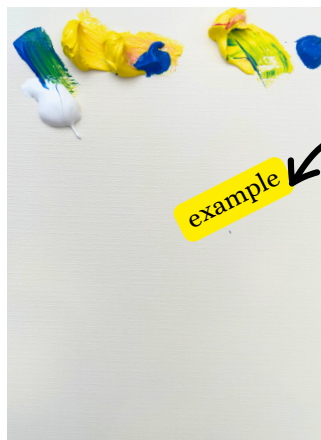

# Color Mixing & Trellis!



## Art Class in a Box

**DO NOT THROW AWAY ANY SCRAPS UNTIL THE END OF THE MONTH!**

1. BEGIN BY USING THE LITTLE PLASTIC SCOOP TO MAKE LITTLE DOTS OF PAINT AT THE TOP OF YOUR PAINTING. SEE THE VIDEO FOR DETAILS ON COLOR MIXING!



2. USE FIVE OF THE PAPERS FOR THE COLOR MIXING. YOU WILL MIX YELLOW + BLUE TO MAKE GREEN. MIX RED + WHITE TO MAKE RED/PINK. RED + YELLOW TO MAKE ORANGE. MAKE A TINT AND SHADE OF BLUE BY ADDING WHITE ON ONE SIDE AND BLACK ON THE OTHER. THEN, MIX RED, YELLOW, + BLUE TO MAKE BROWN.



3. WITH THE REMAINING FOUR PAPERS, MAKE PATTERNS OR A SOLID BLACK COLOR BACKGROUND.



4. DRAW THREE SMALL FLOWERS IN THE CORNER OF THE PINK/ORANGE PAPER. MAKE CIRCLES WHERE THE PAPER IS STILL WHITE. CUT THEM OUT.



5. CUT THIN STRIPS OF THE BROWN-ISH PAPER. THIS WILL LOOK LIKE A TRELLIS!



6. GLUE DOWN ONE END OF THE STRIPS IN A GRID PATTERN (SEE ABOVE) ONTO THE BLACK PAPER. THEN, WEAVE THE TRELLIS TOGETHER. PRESCHOOL: ADULTS HELP WEAVE THE TRELLIS.



7. DRAW SOME CURVY LINES ACROSS THE TOP OF THE PAPER. CUT THAT SECTION OFF OF THE GREEN PAPER. THEN, CUT THE CURVY LINES OUT.



8. PASTE THE FLOWERS AT THE TOP OF EACH STEM.



9. PASTE LEAVES ON THE STEMS.



ADD A FEW MORE LEAVES!

# My Art Class in a Box



1. USE THE MOST ORANGE EDGE OF THE ORANGE/PINK PAPER AND DRAW A LONG CARROT SHAPE.

2. DRAW OUT THE SHAPE OF THE CARROT STEM ON A CORNER OF THE GREEN PAPER.



(SEE BASIC GREEN SHAPE FOR CARROT TOP ABOVE)

3. CUT OUT THE GREEN STEM AND THE ORANGE CARROT.



4. CUT INTO THE GREEN STEM A LITTLE SO IT LOOKS MORE LIKE A CARROT STEM.

5. GLUE DOWN THE STEM & CARROT.



6. DRAW AND CUT OUT THE SHAPE OF A TOMATO. BE SURE TO CUT IT OUT OF THE EDGE OF THE RED/PINK PAPER. GLUE IT DOWN.



7. NEXT, MAKE SMALL CHERRY TOMATOES.



8. GLUE DOWN THE CHERRY TOMATOES. THEN, MAKE LITTLE GREEN STEMS THAT LOOK LIKE LITTLE FLOWERS FOR THE BIG AND LITTLE TOMATOES. GLUE THE STEMS ON TOP OF THE TOMATOES.



9. CUT OUT LITTLE GREEN BEANS AND PASTE THEM DOWN (SEE: CENTER RIGHT OF THE EXAMPLE ABOVE).



10. MAKE A GREEN BROCCOLI STEM AND A BROWN-ISH TOP. CUT THEM OUT AND THEN GLUE THEM DOWN!



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# Funky Mushrooms



## Art Class in a Box



1. LEAVE ENOUGH OF THE PINK/ORANGE PAPER THAT YOU'LL HAVE ENOUGH FOR A SAIL ON THE SAILBOAT NEXT WEEK. WITH THE REST OF THAT PAPER, WE WILL MAKE THE MUSHROOM STEMS AND SOME DOTS FOR THE TOP OF THE GREEN MUSHROOM.



6. MAKE DOTS ON THE GREEN AND BROWN MUSHROOM TOPS. GLUE ALL OF THE PIECES DOWN IF YOU HAVEN'T ALREADY. MAKE THE DOTS ON THE GREEN MUSHROOM ORANGE AND THE DOTS ON THE BROWN TOP WITH A CORNER OF THE BLUE.



2. USE THE ARCH/RAINBOW PATTERN PAPER AS THE BACKGROUND. GLUE THE MUSHROOM STEMS DOWN SPACED OUT SO THERE WILL BE ROOM FOR THE CAPS.



7. CUT OUT SMALL RECTANGLE SHAPES WITH SCRAPS OF THE BROWN PAPER FOR THE BOTTOM RIGHT MUSHROOM. USE SCRAPS OF THE ORANGE COLOR PAPER TO MAKE PETAL SHAPES FOR THE UPPER LEFT MUSHROOM.



3. CUT OUT TWO MUSHROOM TOPS FROM THE RED/PINK PAPER. MAKE THE ONE THAT WILL GO ON THE UPPER LEFT MUSHROOM MORE LIKE AN OVAL SHAPE (BUT STILL A LITTLE LIKE A TRIANGLE SHAPE).

MAKE THE LOWER RIGHT MUSHROOM MORE TRIANGULAR (AS SEEN IN THE IMAGE ABOVE).

4. USE AN EDGE OF THE GREEN PAPER TO MAKE AN UMBRELLA-SHAPED TOP FOR THE UPPER RIGHT CAP.

5. USE THE BROWN-ISH PAPER TO MAKE A CLOUD-LIKE TOP FOR THE BOTTOM LEFT.

# Art Class in a Box



1. WITH THE DOTTED PAPER AS THE BACKGROUND, CUT OUT AN ORANGE CIRCLE FOR A SUN.
2. USE THE YELLOW/GREEN PAPER AND YELLOW/ORANGE PAPER TO MAKE CLOUDS.



3. USE THE LIGHT BLUE PAPER TO CREATE WAVES ON THE BOTTOM HALF OF THE PAPER. GLUE EVERYTHING DOWN ONCE YOU LIKE HOW IT LOOKS.



4. KEEP ADDING BLUE WAVES OF PAPER TO FILL IN MORE WAVES, ESPECIALLY AS YOU USE SLIGHTLY DARKER BLUE PAPER.



5. ADD MORE WAVES, BUT THIS TIME, ADD SOME ORANGE IN THEM!



6. CUT OUT A PINK SAIL AND THEN CUT IT IN HALF SO IT LOOKS LIKE TWO SAILS. PASTE THEM DOWN SO THE SAILS OVERLAP BOTH THE SKY AND THE WATER.



7. SHAPE THE BOAT WITH SOME BLACK PAPER FROM THE DARKEST PART OF THE BLUE PAPER.



8. USE THE REMAINING GREEN AND BROWN PAPER TO MAKE BUSHES ON THE BOTTOM CORNERS OF THE PAPER. ANYTHING ELSE YOU WANT TO ADD?
